In October, Cybersecurity Awareness Month is an excellent opportunity for employers to educate their employees about securing sensitive information. Organizing an engaging and informative event for your security awareness program can be as in-depth or simple as you wish to make it. Below are several interactive and educational event ideas you can plan for Cybersecurity Awareness Month for your employees.



## Capture the Flag (CTF) Challenge

Design a CTF event that requires employees to collaborate and compete in teams to solve security challenges and address vulnerabilities.



## Spot the Phish Challenge

Create fake emails and send them to employees to test their ability to identify and report phishing emails. Those who correctly identify and report phishing attempts should be rewarded for their efforts during the event.



## Escape Room for Cybersecurity

Provide employees with a themed escape room where they must solve puzzles and challenges related to cybersecurity in order to find their way out.



## Trivia/Jeopardy Cybersecurity Game

Jeopardy style trivia game with questions about cybersecurity best practices, current threats, and company security policies.



## Lunch and Learn Workshops

Arrange seminars or workshops on cybersecurity topics during lunch events with food and drinks to encourage attendance.



## Cybersecurity Scavenger Hunt

Create a scavenger hunt themed around cybersecurity topics in which employees must find clues and solve puzzles in order to win prizes.



## Cybersecurity Panel Discussion

Host a panel discussion with cybersecurity experts and company leaders about current security threats, trends, best practices, and recommendations.
